

KEEP YOUR MOBILE PHONE SAFE

This is what you should do to safeguard your mobile phone:

- You should register your phone with both your mobile network and at www.immobilise.com

By registering the IMEI (International Mobile Equipment Identity) number the police can contact you if your phone is stolen and is later handed in or recovered from criminals

- You should also check and record the IMEI number of your phone. You can find this out by typing *#06# into your handset or by looking inside the phone where the SIM card is housed

The IMEI is a unique code that is used to identify an individual mobile phone.

By keeping the 15 digit code safe you can help get your phone blocked if it is stolen, which will mean that the handset can no longer be used on any network.
